The Atkinson Country Club and Resort is located at 85 Country Club Drive accessed from either Providence Hill Road or Shannon Road.

From NH 111: Following the blue highway signs for “AR&CC”, turn south onto Haverhill Road (the street name is unmarked; there is a small Gulf station at the intersection) and follow for .2 miles. Go straight across at the 3-way stop, follow for .4 miles. Bear right at the yellow blinking light and follow this road for 2.1 miles. Turn left onto Clubhouse Drive, follow up hill for .6 miles. Take a left at the end of Clubhouse Drive onto Country Club Drive and the Resort is on your right.

From NH 121: Turn onto Sawyer Avenue, follow Sawyer Avenue for 1.4 miles. Bear slight right onto Providence Hill Road, follow for .5 miles. Turn left onto Country Club Drive and follow for .4 miles. The Resort is on your left.
