

## MEETING MINUTES

### Legislative Policy Committee

**Tuesday, March 23, 2021; 11:00 A.M.**  
**Remote Meeting Via Zoom**

Per RSA 91-A:2, III(b) the RPC Chair has declared the COVID-19 Outbreak an emergency and has waived the requirement that a quorum be physically present at the meeting.

1. Call to order.
2. Reviewed status of the 24 bills included in the municipal watch list.
3. Discussed how RPC comment would need to be structured. RPC should not take a position. Letters should simply present information on anticipated implications of the bill from a municipal and regional planning perspective.
4. Identified five bills for which staff should prepare a summary of anticipated implications for municipal and regional planning.
  - *HB025 – Capital Budget including provision of funds for Coastal Flooding Model*
  - *HB111 – Establishing a cause of action against the state to protect individual rights*
  - *HB279 - Relative to the maximum allowable vehicle gross weight for a combination of truck-trailer and single semi-trailer with 4 or more axles.*
  - *HB630 - Relative to remote board meetings under the right-to-know law and authorizing certain procedures for rulemaking.*
  - *HB439 - Relative to the powers of city councils*
